- 5) **Mary Jane (Watson)** — Spider-Man or Peter Parker's love interest
- 6) **William and Mary** — Williamsburg, Virginia, college, founded in 1693
- 7) **Mary Steenburgen** — Best Supporting Actress Oscar winner for 1980's *Melvin and Howard*
- 8) **Mary Lou Retton** — Gymnast who won a gold medal in the 1984 Olympic Games
- 9) **Mary Shelley** — English author who wrote *Frankenstein, or the Modern Prometheus*
